The Michigan Unemployment Insurance Agency is transitioning MiWAM to a new platform MiUI

On December 15th, the Michigan Unemployment Insurance Agency (UIA) will launch a new platform called the Michigan Unemployment Insurance system (MiUI), which will replace the current system, MiWAM through two phases over 6 months. UIA has already begun phasing out certain MiWAM functions as of November 7th such as eRegistration, business transfers and seasonal employment applications. Here is some notable information about the change and what employers will need to do to comply and gain access to the new system.

The rollout will happen in two phases:






- Phase 1 on December 15th: focuses on tax and employer maintenance functions
- Phase 2 Summer 2026: focuses on benefit related functions

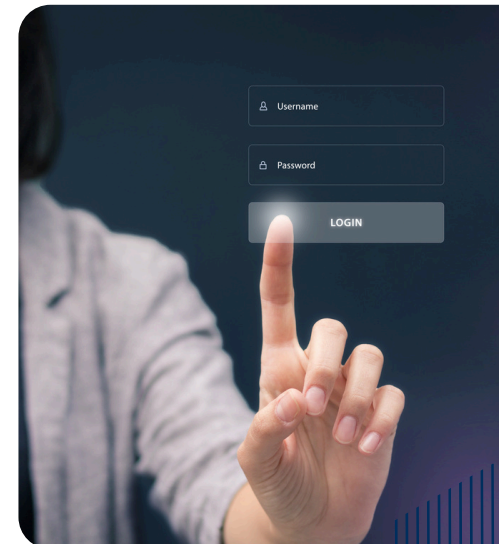
Please note: after the launch of phase one on 12/15 until the completion of phase two next summer, employers and TPAs will use the MiUI and the MiWAM systems in tandem to access all functions.

Here are the steps that should be completed to prepare for the transition:

- Confirm your employer MiWAM account is active.
- Review contact information, payment methods, and user account permissions and update as needed.
- Verify your account administrators.
- Obtain your MiUI activation code through MiWAM.
